- *To build shelters-Yano Mami Tribe from the Amazon Rainforest.
- *To create Rainforest sounds and music.
- *To make a rainmaker, shaker or quiro.
- *To make a Rainforest collage

- *To create co-ordinates/grids for a Rainforest map.
- *To problem solve using money in the Rainforest Café role play.
- *To read number sentences that use + and = signs.
- *To understand the language of length, weight and capacity.

Rumble in the Rainforest

Literacy

- *To read simple fact cards to discuss and sort animals from the Rainforest.
- *To produce a Rainforest factfile of a chosen animal or bird.
- *To read a selection of non-fiction books about Rainforests and animals.

Communication and Language

- *To write a description of a Rainforest setting using adjectives and pictures/knowledge of Rainforests.
- *To write notes/list and a diary as a Rainforest explorer.
- *To retell a Rainforest story e.g. How did the Tiger get his stripes?
- *To recite Jungle stories, rhymes and songs.

- *To research communities in the Amazon/Tropical Rainforests
- *To use an Atlas/Globe to locate Rainforests.
- *To use the Beebot to find animals on the map.
- *To explore and investigate reasons and ways of camouflage for animals in the Rainforest.
