Uniform Costs

We have noticed that the uniform costs we charge to parents haven't changed for a number of years, even though the costs the uniform supplier charges us have increased. This has meant that the school has been subsidising the cost of uniforms (for example, we have been charging parents £9 for a cardigan when the cost to the school has been £10.45). The school is not financially able to continue to do this.

We have increased the prices for uniform on ParentPay to be as follows:-

Raising Concerns with the School

Everyone at Fowey Primary does their very best to provide a brilliant education for all our wonderful children. We are proud of our school and proud of the amazing achievements of our children and our staff. Like any school, there are times when we make mistakes or when parents do not agree or understand why we have taken a particular course of action. When this happens, we would urge you to talk to us, as we do to you when we have concerns. By doing this, we are often able to quickly clarify and explain why we have done something or to apologise if we have something wrong.

The best way to resolve problems is to make an appointment to chat with your child's class teacher, in the first instance. You can do this on pick up or drop off, or via the Office. If you do not feel able to do this, please make an appointment with the Office to speak to me.

We want to work together to ensure the very best for our children.

Volunteers for Swimming, Wednesday Workshops and Trips

A huge thank you to all the parents who have volunteered to help this term with swimming and Wednesday Workshops. It wouldn't be possible for us to safely offer these activities without your help and I know that the children have really benefitted from chatting with you on the bus.



Earrings and PE

We are very sorry that we have caused some unintentional confusion around earrings and PE this week. The uniform policy at Fowey has been in place for a number of years and states that children will need to remove jewellery, including earrings and watches when asked by an adult. This includes for PE and PE based clubs. Some staff have always done this but some have been asking children to cover earrings with tape, which has caused confusion. This has meant that some families have, very understandably, been surprised when staff have asked children to remove their earrings as this has not been their previous experience.

We will review this policy next term with the PVG group, in order to make our expectations around this clearer for everyone. We will then send this policy out to everyone.

If you have any thoughts on this, we would encourage you to speak to your class PVG reps to ensure that your views are represented in our discussion.

For now, we will ask children to either remove their earrings or cover them with tape/plasters for PE. Some parents have told us that they are uncomfortable with staff helping children to do this so children will need to be able to do this themselves. If your child isn't able to do this, please consider sending them in without earrings on PE/ club days.

We do need to remind you that the reason we ask children to remove their earrings for PE is because it is safest for everyone if children have no jewellery while doing PE. Not only can earrings cause injuries to your child, if they catch them on something, but they can also cause scratches to other children.

Oceans, Breakfast Club and School Lunch Debts

Like many schools, Fowey Primary is managing a very challenging budget. There are some families who, often unintentionally, have very large amount owing on ParentPay. This is meaning that Oceans and school lunches are running at a significant loss, which the school cannot sustain. We would encourage all parents to ensure that any amounts owing are paid.

If you are experiencing financial difficulty, please do come and talk to us as we are happy to work out a payment plan for people, particularly if you find that you owe a larger amount than you were expecting.

In order to avoid this situation in the future, from Easter we will be setting a cap of £10, per family on ParentPay debts. If your family owes more than £10 we will be unable to accept any more bookings for Oceans or Breakfast Club until this has been cleared.
