

When outgrown, it is expected that they will transition to black items.

Summer dresses – blue and white checked only

Socks/Tights—Plain black socks or tights. Plain white socks with summer dresses.

Black shoes — smart, waterproof, plain black shoes only (not trainers)

Please note: trainers, including all black ones, are not permitted for school uniform.

Boots of any kind, sandals, shoes with heels are not permitted.
