**Trousers/Skirt/Pinafore**—Black trousers, shorts, skirts or pinafores.

Skirts must be knee length or longer.

*Please note, it has been agreed that children can continue to wear grey during 2022-23 if their grey items still fit.*

*When outgrown, it is expected that they will transition to black items.*

**Summer dresses** – blue and white checked only

**Socks/Tights**—Plain black socks or tights. Plain white socks with summer dresses.

**Black shoes** — smart, waterproof, plain black shoes only (not trainers)

*Please note: trainers, including all black ones, are not permitted for school uniform.*

*Boots of any kind, sandals, shoes with heels are not permitted.*

### **Kids Eat for £1**

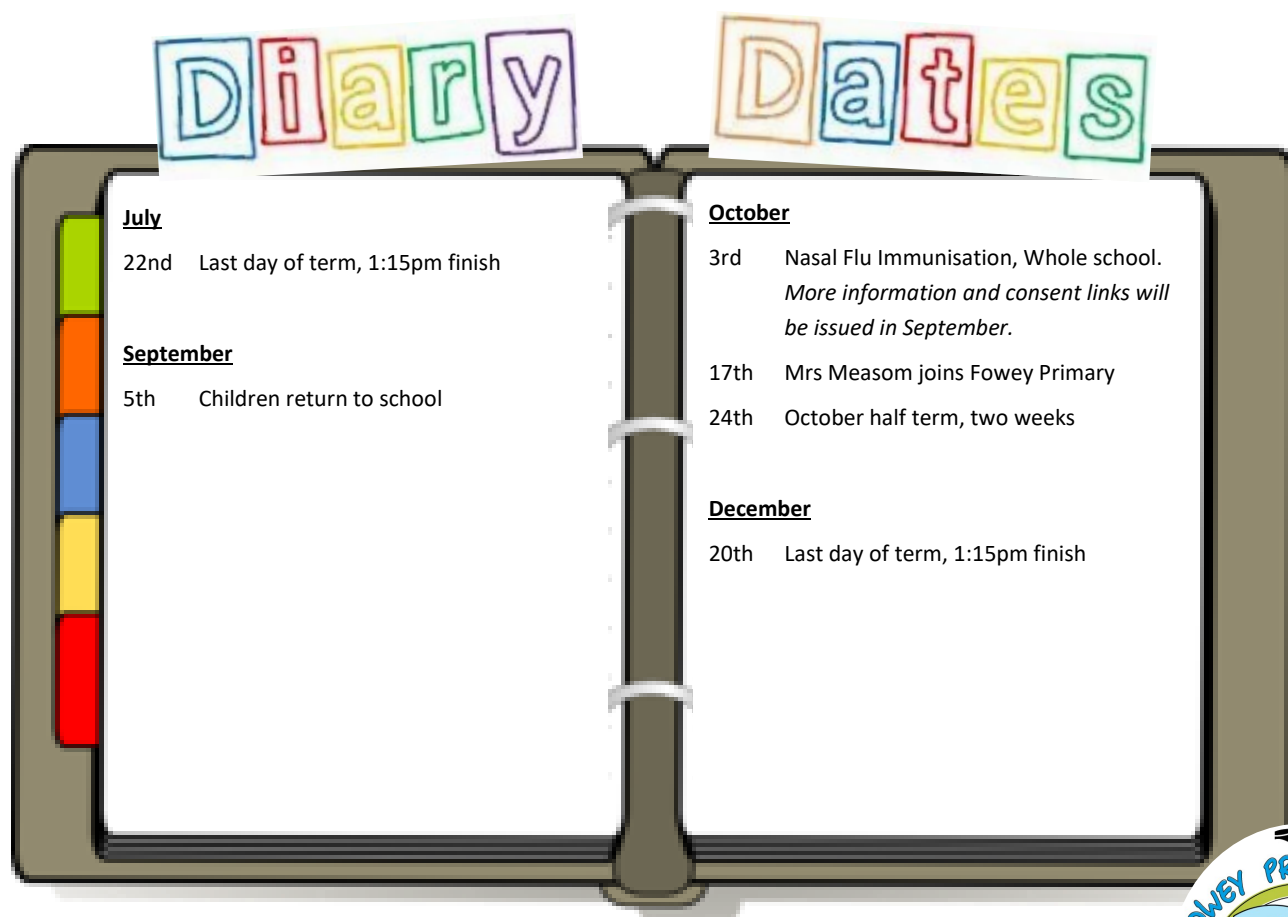
