We are delighted to share with you the children's learning experiences so far this term.



In their Power Maths sessions the children have been looking at addition and subtraction using a number line to 10. They rolled a dice



Cannis have started the term with their new class topic, 'The Enchanted Woodland'. The children we have been looking at plants and learning what environments are best for them to grow and survive. They have planted their own peas and are excited to watch them grow! The children loved their visit from an 'enchanted' fairy!










The children in Coombe class have been exploring pattern and texture. They enjoyed creating their own repeating pattern and making rubbings to use in their frottage masterpiece next week.



In P.E, the children have been thinking about the skills they need to have to be an effective team member. The children have also been developing their throwing skills, to throw accurately at a target.



Polridmouth have been learning about volcanoes as part of their new topic, Tremors.



The children created pictures of volcanoes using a variety of art-based materials such as tissue paper, chalk and paint. Miss Rowe is so impressed with the artwork produced that she has put them up on display! In English, the children have been focusing on poetry-based techniques such as similes, alliteration, and powerful verbs. They created their own 'rocking volcano' poems which were fantastic!



Gribben class have made an excellent start to their new project 'Traders and Raiders'. The children created their own version of Anglo Saxon helmets like the ones discovered at Sutton Hoo. They really enjoyed their virtual tour of the Anglo Saxon area of the National History Museum!

In computing, the children used a new programme '2Logo' to send controls and instructions to create different shapes.





Readymoney have enjoyed an excellent start to the summer term with their

new topic, 'Pharaohs'. The children have all really enjoyed delving into

Ancient Egyptian history. For their topic launch day last week, they researched mummification, and used this learning to mummify tomatoes! They even scooped out the tomato seeds to simulate removing the internal organs. It was very messy but so much fun! Their tomatoes are now drying out in the classroom cupboard.











Carne class have enjoyed getting stuck into their new topic, Hola Mexico.

The children opened their topic by exploring Mexican culture and traditions.

They particularly enjoyed listening to Mexican music performances and learning about Dia de los Muertos (Day of the Dead). The highlight, however, was making Mexican 'mocktails'!
