Summary of Learning Walk:

JG and JJ observed the following strengths:

- All staff led their phonics session with enthusiasm and energy.
- All pupils were engaged and active in their phonics learning.
- Verbal responses and written consolidation from pupils was seen in all phonics sessions.
- Pupils were able to tell JG what they were learning. "We are doing the alternative pronunciation of 'ch' today" and where they were in their learning "I am at the end of Phase 5 phonics and today I am revising the key sounds".
- A range of activities were seen: singing of the A-Z, use of fists or sound buttons for counting phonemes in a word and a quick fire word game.
- JG and JJ met with two Yr 1 children who were confident in their ability to discuss their phonics journey.
- Consistent and confident use of terminology by pupils when discussing phonemes and graphemes.
- Consistent use ICT by staff.
- Use of white boards and pens as well as the visual/interactive use of Giant Phonics power point to make activities interactive and inclusive.

Areas for improvement and actions:

- All classrooms to have a current display which embeds the learning taken place in each of the phonic
 sessions that day. Key sounds/words for all phases taught in the class will be on display to allow all pupils to
 consolidate their learning. JJ to look into resources and board ideas, so that staff and pupils have an active
 role in helping the phonics board to be current and up to date.
- Accuracy of pronunciation for certain letter sounds. JJ to give staff individual feedback where necessary.
