School Lunches

The lunchtime at Fowey has been slightly shortened as the length of play time at lunch was very long compared to other schools and we felt this contributed to silly behaviour outside last year. At the beginning of term our new Lantic children were very slow to eat and this was causing a knock on delay for older children. We believe we have now rectified this problem and we are confident all children do have long enough to eat. Some children, however, prefer not to eat all of their packed lunch so they get a longer playtime. We would be grateful if you could remind children that the top priority at lunchtime is making sure they have eaten all they would like to.

Daily Exercise

Although Fowey already offers far more exercise on a weekly basis than is statutory for Primary Schools, we agree with some parents that daily exercise is an important habit for us all to learn. To support this, three classes will be trialling a ten minute run, three times a week. They will do this in their school uniform (as it is intended to be done mid-lesson when they need a mini-break) but children should ensure they have PE shoes in school at all times so they can change into their trainers.

The classes undertaking the trial will be Lantic, Coombe and Readymoney.
