Year Six SATS Week

Year Six will be taking their SATS tests on Mon 13th -Thurs 16th May. The dates are set nationally and this year they will do:

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling on Monday

Reading on Tuesday

Maths (two tests) Arithmetic and Reasoning on Wednesday

Maths (one test) Reasoning on Thursday

We will have a lovely, fun day on Friday with no tests!

It is very important that all Year 6 children are in school on time, every day this week. Any absence of Year Six children during this week, due to illness, must be accompanied by a doctor's note so that we can notify the Standards and Testing Authority. If your child should have any exceptional circumstances during the week (e.g. a close family member is hospitalised or a pet dies unexpectedly) please do let us know on that day so we can make individual arrangements.

We will have SATS breakfast each day (Mon-Thurs) at 8:15 in the hall. Please do send all children in at this earlier time so we can have a good breakfast and get off to a calm and settled start. Children are welcome to bring in a small mascot/comforter to go on their desk while they work if they would like. We will provide all the stationary and equipment children need so you won't need to send any in.

They also all need a water bottle to keep with them during the tests (especially if it is warm).
