Dear Parents and Carers

We have been blessed with wonderful weather this week at Fowey (apart from today) and we are delighted that the sun shone for the D-Day commemorations on Thursday. Thank-you to all the parents who collected their children to take them to see events in the town first-hand. We have worked with children across the school this week to commemorate the events 75 years ago.

We have been very pleased this week to have secured some additional funding to replace the slabs at the back of the school (by the field) with a much more suitable play surface (we're hoping for tarmac with some wet-pour soft play areas). We do have lots of accidents on the current slabs as they are so uneven and they make access difficult for our wheelchair users. We hope to also be able to expand the play area out a little so that the children have more space and everyone is better able to get to classrooms on pick up. Unfortunately, this does mean we will lose some of our beautiful trees, which is such a shame, but we really do need the additional space and we hope that the benefits of more all-year play space will outweigh their loss. We are hoping to find some money for some potted trees so that the roots don't damage the surfacing but there is still shade on hot days.
