As some of you are aware, my daughter has a congenital heart defect and has now had four surgeries at Evelina London Children's Hospital (which is a specialist, national hospital offering support for children with complex health needs). Congenital Heart defects are the most common congenital condition in the UK.

In February they are celebrating Congenital Heart Disease awareness month and I would like us to join in by wearing something red on Valentine's Day and making small donations to the Evelina Children's Heart Organisation who work to support families over the UK whose children have heart needs.

We will be doing a special assembly on this day to talk about different children and what it can be like to be a child who spends lots of time in hospital.
